

Appendix 1: Three Year Rotating Curriculum Quick Reference

Dancercise Kids has operated this curriculum on a three year rotating basis, ideal for the typical cycle of a pre-school age dancer. The curriculum repeats the Fitness and Creative Movements dances, since the instructor can vary those as necessary and these operate as standard warm-up and wind-down activities. Each unit (which corresponds to a month when used as originally designed) has three new dances so there is plenty of new material for the children to learn.

The following pages summarize the songs and dances available with each year of the curriculum, and also show how those songs are associated with compact discs suitable for retail sale directly from store.dancercise.com or other retail outlets, or via you as a Dancercise Kids licensee and your affiliate code which can generate commission for you on sales of Dancercise Kids music.
